What is Go Up project about?

The Go Up project aims to boost the participation of refugees, asylum seekers and migrants in adult education supporting teachers, educators and counsellors with tailor made innovative methodologies and tools designed to build resilience and enhance intercultural competencies through theatre techniques.



The Kick Off Meeting of the Project

The kick off meeting of the project took place at Valladolid, Spain, on the 20th of November 2018.

One of the firsts steps taken at the beginning of the meeting, was to introduce a brief presentation of each partner describing their experience related to Go Up project objectives: SOLIM team related their experience about gender and immigration; PERA exposed their practice with artistic and theatre techniques; IASIS described their transferable projects (Connectathens and Fabrik Republic), etc.

The following step was to introduce an overview about the Go Up project drawing its principal aspects as: its main topics (resilience, intercultural competences, theatre techniques), objectives, target group, outputs, timeline, etc.

The potential users of this project outputs are: Adult education teachers, trainers, tutors and counsellors. The final beneficiaries of the project are refugees, asylum seekers, migrants.

The final objective of the project is to provide to adult education professionals, tutors trainers and counsellors with innovative methodologies and tools to support refugees, asylum seekers and migrants to build resiliency and improve the implementation of inclusive education.

Go Up project consists in designing and developing pedagogical, innovative, intercultural and inclusive theatre techniques to improve the implementation of inclusive education



Project Outputs

The project will develop the following Intellectual Outputs:

IO1. Go Up ONLINE DIGITAL DATABASE of good practices and resources in Intercultural and Inclusive Theatre

An online tool that offers to adult education teachers and trainers innovative methodologies and inspirational good practices and resources to develop intercultural and inclusive Theatre projects.

IO2. TRAINING CURRICULUM for Intercultural and Inclusive Theatre.

An ECVET curriculum (based on European Credit System for Vocational Education and Training) for the assessment, validation and recognition of Intercultural and Inclusive Theatre learning outcomes.

IO3. Go Up PEDAGOGICAL HANDBOOK on Intercultural and Inclusive Theatre.

An Open Educational Resource (OER) aimed to provide innovative pedagogical and methodological approaches on the use of theatre techniques to teach intercultural competencies and support the cultural integration of refugees, asylum seekers and migrants.

IO4. Go Up TOOLBOX for Intercultural and Inclusive Theatre

A multilingual OER with a set of practical contents, activities and methods to provide adult education teachers, trainers, tutors and counsellors, at national and European level, with theatre techniques as useful tools to apply in their daily routine to teach intercultural competencies and support the cultural integration of refugees, asylum seekers
